Message from Pastor David Kerk

What is “Sengkang” Doing in Kulai?

Last Monday while I was riding on the horseback in the palm oil plantations in Kulai, I was reminded of the 3-points sermon shared by Bro. Joe especially on the area of spiritual warfare at ground level - reaching out with the gospel of good news. This thought impressed me further more while we drove into the town of Kulai where, to our surprise, we saw a few road signs with the word ‘SENGKANG’. While, I sat at the front seat in the car with the brethren, the following impressions stand out:

(1) I Recall the Vision of bringing Christ to Sengkang.

How can we reach more people? Is there a better way to do it? I refuse to get bogged down in the details of filling up the chapel. These words flashed back my mind “Where there is no vision, the people perish” Proverbs 29:18a (KJV)

I remember the words of our Lord in John 4:35 - “Do you not say, ‘Four months more and then the harvest?’ I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest...”

(2) I Refuse to get Enmeshed in petty factions

And I talked to myself as I pondered on Bro. Joe’s expression of “we are only one year in Sengkang & it will take a little more time for us to bond deeper”.

Amen! All of us can avoid any entanglement by staying focus on the larger issue of winning the lost. Words of apostle Paul to the church in Corinth rang loud in my ears “You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere men? For when one says, “I follow Paul,” and another, “I follow Apollos,” are you not mere men?” Read 1 Corinthians 2:2-3

(3) I Refuse to Criticise others

While we were waiting for the brethren in the other car to join us for lunch, many wild thoughts crossed our mind “What’s taking them so long? We are hungry”. Then, the wisdom of Dr. Billy Graham came upon me when he was criticised for being “liberals” in his evangelistic crusades, he would be gracious to his critics with the words from 1 Peter 2:23 “When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly.”

(4) I Responded to His Call

By His Grace and in His time, I am humbled that our Lord has shown us that “S rainbow” to affirm that vision to Sengkang. When I get to heaven, the first question I am going to ask my God is “Why did You choose to use a “broken” man like me?”

Till that glorious Day, I just got to wait on God to develop all our plans and let HIM accomplish them. I’ll have to remain faithful “parking” myself at the city gate of Sengkang even if it appears absurd to win the whole SENGGKANG while we are at this ulu old punggol road. Well, we just got to obey our God and stay truthful & faithful to the vision.
