Message from Pastor David Kerk

Believing God In Every Situation

Last Sunday, I sat at the back row of the chapel listening to Sis Ching's message on Storms of Life. My spirit was deeply lifted up when she quoted 2 Corinthians 1:4 which states "(God) comforts us..... that we may be able to comfort those who are in trouble."

At that moment, I sat there recalling some years ago I went through a time of painful emotional loss. Just I needed most, a close brother who had experienced a similar situation comforted me and then offered these words "In The Future, Christ can use your emotional wounds to help other." Some time later, I remember visiting to a Christian bookshop, I saw a portrait of Jesus' nailed-pierced hands. Below it, was these 3 words "He Touched Me." - something happened now I know!

"Rarely have I experienced a string of circumstances that spoke so vividly to my situation. In His gracious providence, God used them to comfort and direct me. It became clear that the Healing Grace from the wounded Hands of Jesus and that wounds can help others. Bro Jason Kua led us to sing "Healing Grace of God" that release us from our past. The lyrics in this song are very theological with such encouraging words: Merciful God and Father loving us like no other. Hear our prayer the cry of our hearts as we come to You. We acknowledge our transgression, we confess to You our sins. Show us mercy and compassion. Touch our lives with Your Healing Grace again. I was very comforted with these words "release us from our past as we seek Your face. Wash us free at last." That's what we desire each time we worship our Lord, He can minister to us through the preached Word that cleanses and heals our soul. So, the next time satan reminds us of our past; we remind him of our future - In God's Good Hand & His Healing Grace - hallelujah, His blood cleanses us from all sins.

In hindsight, I have learned how God's comfort in suffering can build bridges in pain. Indeed, Jesus is our 'BRIDGE' over troubled waters especially when we are weary and feeling small inside us. Apostle Paul made this point clear: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord

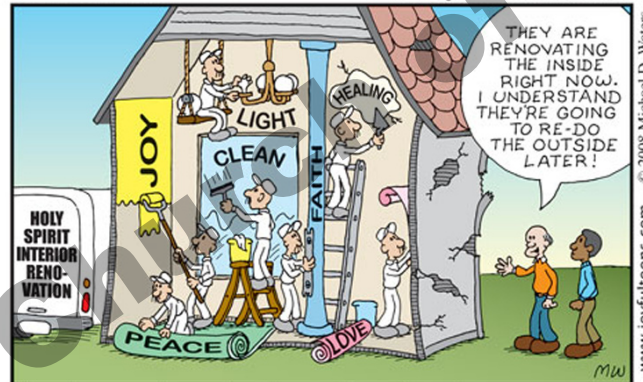
