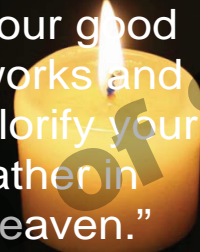

Enhancing Relationship **TRUST**

A **BROKEN** Relationship is NOT easily repaired. Once FAITH & TRUST have been broken, the road back is rocky. Wounded loved-one ended up feeling bruised, hurt and bitter.

It takes a **TENDER**, Sensitive, Loving man to Restore a Broken Relationship.

Four Characteristics of a TENDER man

1. Initiates HEALING

Matthew 5:23-24. Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift. Beloved, go and make good that broken relationship with your brethren first.

2. LISTEN attentively

To Rebuild relationship requires active listening. How does a medical doctor prescribes medication to a physically sick body? By asking questions and listening attentively to the patient. Beloved, let's learn to give a listening to a wounded brethren.

3. Express REMORSE and Seek FORGIVENESS

Matthew 6:14-15 For if you Forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly...

Luke 17:3-4 If your brother sins, REBUKE him and if he Repents, FORGIVE him.

4. PERSEVERE

When reconciliation is NOT immediate. Reconciliation has 2 main meanings. It signifies the restoration of accord and harmony between parties who were at odds with one another or it refers to the setting of a dispute or disagreement between parties. Reconciliation involves a change of attitudes, because attitudes are all important in relationships. Even born-again spirit-filled christians do not generally act on their beliefs, but act in accordance with their attitudes. Attitudes are shown by the way they behave. It is the responsible attitudes & behaviors that hinder spirit-filled brethren reconciling their disagreements. Knowing this will help to wait upon the conviction of the Holy Spirit to clear any odds between brethren.

Title of Message: Disciples Becoming Christians

Scripture Text: Acts 11:26

And in Antioch the Disciples were for the FIRST time called Christians.

Introduction:

The disciples of Jesus Christ were called Christians first in the city of Antioch, where the church was composed primarily of Gentile believers. In Acts 11:24 Barnabas, a good man full of the Holy Spirit, was well-known for the encouragement he gave people. A large number of people were converted and added to the church through his ministry read Acts 11:19-26. Others beheld the beauty of Jesus Christ in them. Indira Gandhi, former prime minister of India, has been quoted as saying that if Christians would act like Jesus Christ, India would be at His feet. The greatest hindrance to the Christian evangelism is the low quality of life that some Christians display to the world.

Main Points:

- 2:1 Conversion is God's Plan for Your Life
- 2:2 Low Quality of Life that Does NOT reveal the LIFE Christ wants to Produce
- 2:3 Nominal Christian Living - Not winning the unbelieving world to Faith In Our Savior

3. Disciples Become Christians When Respond to the Holy SPIRIT!

To Be Genuinely Christian a person MUST Make a Positive Response to the Presence and the Purpose of the Indwelling Spirit.

- 3:1 Romans 8:16 For His SPIRIT joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's Children
 - Our Relationship to God. We Are His children
- 3:2 1 Corinthians 3:16 Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the SPIRIT of GOD lives in you.
 - Our Response & Respect the Indwelling Holy Spirit
- 3:3 Philippians 2:13 For GOD is working in you, giving you the DESIRE and the POWER to do what pleases HIM
 - Our Co-operation With the Indwelling Holy Spirit
 - Our Conversation, Conduct, Character Powered by the SPIRIT

Reflection on this Message

The Holy SPIRIT invites the non-believers to put FAITH in Jesus Christ as Lord & Savior. The Holy SPIRIT is seeking continually to magnify and exalt Jesus Christ as the Savior who alone can bring the gift of FORGIVENESS and new Life to the non-believers. As for His disciples, our Master desires of us to be genuine in our Relationship, Response & Respect in Co-operation with the Holy SPIRIT. An obedient disciple of Christ produces conversation, conduct & character that PLEASES HIM.
