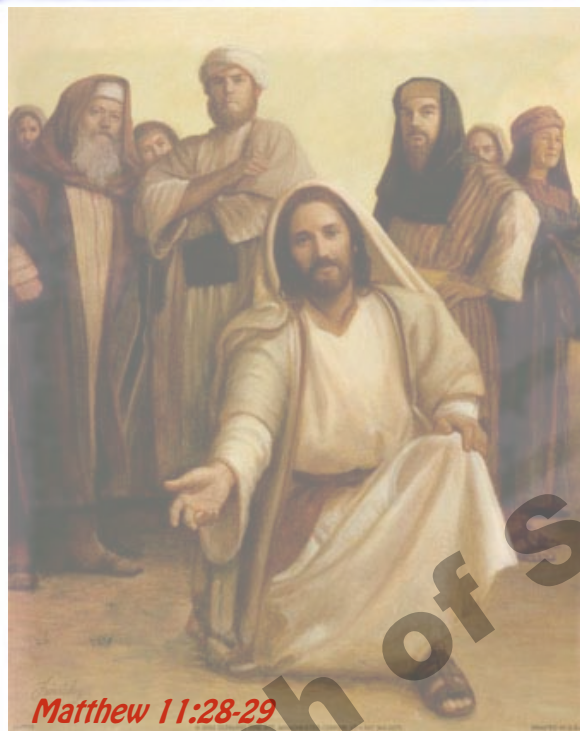
#### 2. Take His Yoke - Matthew 11:28-29

Text: **Luke 9:23-26**

Intro:

Servanthood is a broad topic. But it is a sought after topic for the Christians. Serving Christ is easy to think and desire for, but in reality it is a journey that speaks of things that are so opposite to what we expect about ourselves.

### A. Points to Ponder

- I. A point of deep decision making
